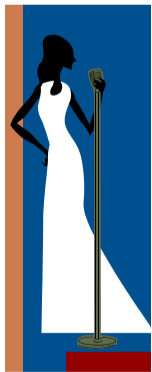
Annual Meeting

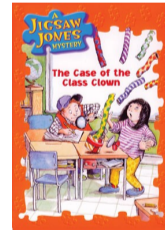

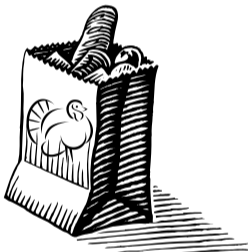

Family Volunteer Day

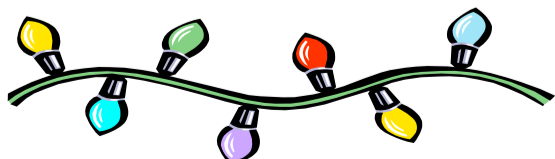
