What is Arts Day?

NYS ARTS organizes a yearly advocacy effort where arts leaders and artists from all corners of New York State

will meet lawmakers in Albany to make the case for protecting the New York State Council on the Arts budget. Here are the facts from the Governor's proposed 2010-2011 budget:

- Local assistance (grants) funding was cut 6.5 million or 15.5 %.
- NYS Arts Operations budget was cut 10% requiring reorganization and reduction of 10 positions.

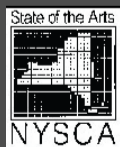

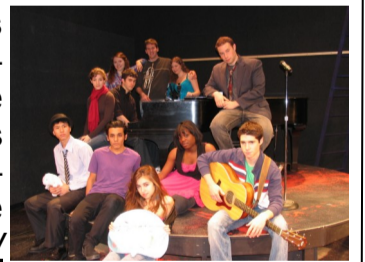

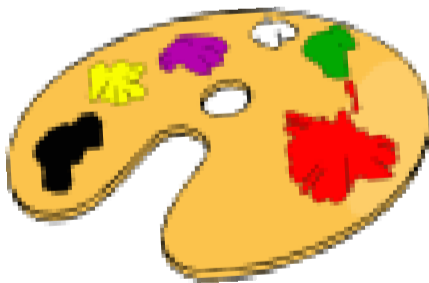
